

NAME

dstat – show the status of dmover jobs

SYNOPSIS

dstat
dstat [-u user]

DESCRIPTION

The dstat command is a utility wrapper used to request the status of dmover jobs. dstat will output information by each job identifier or by all dmover jobs at a target destination. dstat mirrors the options available via qstat. See qstat(1) for more details.

EXAMPLES

Typical usage of dstat consists of Synopsis 1 and 2. Synopsis 1 will show all dmover jobs in queue that the user has status privileges to see. Synopsis 2 will display dmover jobs in alternate format. Again, See qstat(1) for more details.

CAVEATS

dstat commands should not specify servername or job queue of any kind. This is configured as part of the dmover installation.
